Pilatus Business Aircraft Ltd. Expanding in Jefferson County

[Pilatus Business Aircraft Ltd.](#) is expanding its operations in unincorporated Jefferson County. The company has plans to build a new 118,000 square-foot facility at the Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport (RMMA).



The new \$22 million facility will replace and expand its current operations at RMMA, and provide aircraft completion support for the Pilatus PC-12 and the PC-24 aircraft. The project will nearly double employment and bring an estimated 57 high-paying jobs and more than \$3 million in capital investment to Jefferson County.
